

HOME RUN

This 400-square-foot gentleman's closet is custom-tailored, as is the home overall. Recently purchased from the original owner, an MLB player, the Gilbert custom comprises 9,326 square feet of livable space and includes five bedrooms, six bathrooms and a detached 6,600-square-foot separate man cave. But we were particularly intrigued by the his and hers closets, the latter of which rises to a second level. In progress for three seasons, the estate was finished in 2015 by Mesa-based **Red Rock Contractors and Red Rock Pools and Spas**. The luxury club-level closet includes custom LED panels behind the shoes, extensive drawers and storage, a TV that pops from the island, a zinc-countertop desk, a lounge chair and ottoman, plush silk carpeting, a pinstripe wallcovering, a large saltwater fish tank that looks through from the master shower, and a private master garden and water-feature." Our vision for the room was to create a very elegant yet masculine ambience to the master closet," says Rick Chafey, who studied construction engineering at ASU and started the Red Rock company in 2009. Scottsdale's Angelica Henry provided the interior design. "We made sure to also make it match the luxury of the balance of the home," he adds. "Part of the luxury was to also make sure it felt comfortable and lived in, not sterile." Many questions were asked. Personalization is what makes this space special, Chafey explains. How many shoes, jackets, pants? What will be displayed in front of the LED-lit wall? In this case, the extensive collection of Nike Air Jordans provide color contrasts and panache against the Dodger-blue lights. Other blue finishes include Italian leather and flannel wall fabrics. "The zinc countertops and glazed alder cabinetry impart a wonderful aged quality to the space, and contrast with the carpet's luxurious wool and silk blend," Henry explains. In addition, mica inserts in the steel-framed light fixtures cast an amber glow, and bright LED lights in the custom closet rods light the clothing. "Everything came together to enhance the club aesthetic," she adds, "and several of the materials were pulled in from other areas of the home to create a sense of continuity between spaces."
